The degree awarded is exactly the same as that is being awarded on the UK campus as they have the same curriculum and comply with the same stringent quality standards.

The LLB programme offered at UoRM is fully accredited by the Malaysian Qualification Agency. The LLB offered at the University of Reading, UK and at the University of Reading Malaysia is recognised for the purposes of pursuing the Legal Practice Course (UK) and the Bar Practice Course (UK). The programme is also recognised by the Legal Professional Qualifying Board (MY) to pursue the Certificate of Legal Practice (CLP).

The Reading LLB provides the perfect balance of academic learning and practical experience. One key aspect of the high-quality learning experience is the applied, problem-solving approach to learning in which students are presented with authentic cases to examine and discuss.
